Documents to be Provided by the Applicant

- **Minimum GCE Advance Level Certificate or BAC:** Applicants must possess a minimum GCE Advance Level certificate or BAC. If you do not meet this requirement, please refrain from contacting us.
- **German Language Proficiency (Goethe Institute Certificate B1):** All applicants are required to demonstrate proficiency in the German language with a Goethe Institute Certificate B1. We also welcome applications from individuals willing to study the German language for a minimum of six months for B1 and eight months for B2 for those wishing to pursue a nursing career.
- **Passport Data Page:** Please provide a copy of the passport data page. If it is not available, we recommend initiating the passport application process immediately.
- **Passport Size Photo:** Please provide a passport-size photo taken on a white background. If needed, we can assist in taking the photo on the spot free of charge.
- **Birth Certificate:** Please provide a copy of your birth certificate.

Age Requirement:

Applicants must be between 18 and 29 years old.

Service Process

Payment: The total cost of the German language B1 training is **800,000 CFA francs** and **1,000,000 CFA francs** for B2 (required for nursing)

An initial deposit of **200,000 CFA francs** is required to start the payment plan for the German language training. Thereafter, a monthly payment of **100,000 CFA francs** is due for the remaining duration of the training. This then grants eligibility for the language certification exams.

After obtaining a visa and job contract, the remaining balance of **7,200,000 CFA francs** should be paid upon arrival and commencement of work in Germany. We offer a flexible payment plan of **300,000 CFA francs** in 24 installments over two years.

Offer and Interview:

You will receive an offer within 48 hours and be scheduled for an interview with the employer within a one- to two-month period.

Employment Training Contract:

Upon successful selection, you will be required to sign an employment training contract with the employer.

Visa Application:

We do not require blocked accounts or bank statements for the visa application.
